ITT Industries, Pure-Flo® Solutions Group Introduces the 970 Stainless Steel (970 SS) Bonnet for Hygienic Diaphragm Valves.

(Lancaster, PA) - As a complement to the existing Pure-Flo® hygienic valve product line, ITT Industries, Pure-Flo Solutions Group recently announced the introduction of the 970 Stainless Steel bonnet.

The 970 SS bonnet is designed to provide cost effective quality performance in critical process applications. The bonnet is manufactured from 316L stainless steel with a Thermoplastic PAS (Polyarylsulfone) hand wheel.

The 970 SS bonnet is an autoclavable, stainless steel version of the well received 950 PBT bonnet. Similarities with the 950 PBT bonnet include a rising handwheel that reveals a position indicator, an adjustable travel stop, and sanitary internals. The stainless steel design provides superior protection against alcohol, chloride, and most caustic washdowns.

This 970 SS bonnet will complement, and is interchangeable with the existing 963 PAS and 950 PBT bonnet assemblies. The 970 SS bonnet will include hygienic internals as a standard.

The 970 Stainless Steel Bonnet is available in sizes 0.50" (DN 15), 0.75" (DN 20), 1.00" (DN 25), 1.50" (DN 40), and 2.00" (DN 50).
